
#### Class 3's Victorian Day – A Journey Back in Time!

This week, Class 3 were transported back to the 19th century for a fully immersive day as part of their Victorian History unit. The children looked absolutely fantastic dressed in full Victorian attire – we had an incredible mix of chimney sweeps, mine workers, and some very well-to-do young ladies and gentlemen!

The day began with a taste of real Victorian schooling. Under the watchful eye of our very strict Victorian teacher, the children took part in traditional lessons focused on the 3R's – reading, writing and arithmetic. We also explored some of the harsh punishments of the era (you'll be pleased to hear that no one received the cane or had to don the dreaded dunce cap!).

In the afternoon, we put our creative hats on with a writing session imagining a Victorian packed lunch – the children's ideas were brilliant and surprisingly authentic! To round off the day, we discovered how Victorian children spent their time after school. We had lots of fun playing traditional games such as Jacks, pick-up sticks, spinning tops, skipping ropes and hopscotch.




#### Y5 Languages Fair ~ Thursday 5 June 2025


