

Children, who have been coming in weekly for their Rocksteady sessions with Alex, will be taking part in their second concert next week, on Wednesday 9 July 2025, performing for their parents/carers.

Children can come to school in their 'rock band' outfits but must bring their school uniform to change into following the concert.

This event is organised by Rocksteady and parents/carers have already been informed about this event via the Rocksteady portal.

Alex has also sent us this parental reminder: Please don't come into school earlier than 9am. Due to space available in the school hall, there is space for up to 2 family members per Rocksteady pupil to come and watch the concert. End of Financial Year ~ Outstanding Payments

It is extremely important that all SchoolGateway and SchoolGrid accounts are up-to-date, and <u>a zero or credit balance remains on accounts</u> when school closes on Friday 18 July 2025. This is the end of our school financial year and a busy time in the school office when all financial records are finalised to enable the YCAT finance team to close down the accounts for the year.

Year 6 Leavers

This is particularly important if your child is in Year 6 and about to leave us at the end of July and the following should be noted:

- If a credit balance remains on your child's account and you have other children remaining in the school, the credit amount will be transferred to the sibling account.
- If a credit balance remains on your child's account and you have no other children in school, a refund will be made via SchoolGateway.
- Your SchoolGrid and SchoolGateway accounts <u>must</u> show a zero or credit balance on 18 July, when your child leaves the school.


