Summer Reading Challenge Assembly ~ Tuesday 8 July 2025

On Tuesday 8 July, we welcomed Helenne and Alison from the Library Service who talked to the children in assembly about this year's reading challenge, 'Story Garden', which is themed around nature and the great outdoors.

The annual Summer Reading Challenge is delivered in partnership with public libraries across the UK, and it's free for children to take part. Throughout the summer, children joining 'Story Garden' can discover new books, participate in free activities at their local library, and explore the link between reading and the great outdoors, where nature and imagination come together.

The challenge for children is to read 6 library books of their choice and collect special stickers and other prizes along the way – everyone who finishes will receive a limited-edition Story Garden medal and a certificate. Any child aged 4 to 11 can join in and the challenge runs from Saturday 12 July until Saturday 6 September.

Year 5 Day at South Craven School ~ Thursday 10 July 2025




On Tuesday our Year 5 children joined all the other Year 5 children from the cluster schools for a special day at South Craven School.

End of Financial Year ~ Outstanding Payments

It is extremely important that all SchoolGateway and SchoolGrid accounts are up-to-date, and <u>a zero or credit balance remains on accounts</u> when school closes on Friday 18 July 2025. This is the end of our school financial year and a busy time in the school office when all financial records are finalised to enable the YCAT finance team to close down the accounts for the year.

Year 6 Leavers

This is particularly important if your child is in Year 6 and about to leave us at the end of July and the following should be noted:

- If a credit balance remains on your child's account and you have other children remaining in the school, the credit amount will be transferred to the sibling account.
- If a credit balance remains on your child's account and you have no other children in school, a refund will be made via SchoolGateway.
- Your SchoolGrid and SchoolGateway accounts <u>must</u> show a zero or credit balance on 18 July, when your child leaves the school.
