During the session, staff reviewed the key vocabulary linked to each of the 17 learning skills and discussed practical ways to embed these principles even more deeply into everyday school life.

By consistently modelling this language with the children and encouraging them to identify and reflect on their own targets for each skill, we aim to make the Learning for Life approach a natural and integral part of our school's learning culture.
