## Stone Age Day

On Wednesday, Class 3 stepped back in time and enjoyed a fantastic Stone Age Day, packed with hands-on learning and memorable experiences.

The children explored flint knapping, safely using soap instead of real flint, to create their own hand axe, and took part in an excavation of coprolites to help them understand what people ate during the Stone Age. They also tried their hand at archery, learning how early humans hunted for their food.

Creativity played a big part in the day too. The children worked together to build a biscuit Stonehenge, and they were fascinated to handle and identify real artefacts from our Stone Age box kindly loaned by Craven Museum who have some wonderful pieces in the museum. Why not spend some time there in half term to see what other artefacts you could find? In the afternoon, they created their own cave paintings, bringing together everything they had learned about life in prehistoric times.

The children were enthusiastic, curious, and fully immersed in the experience. They are already incredibly excited to channel what they learned into some fantastic Stone Age-inspired writing next week.
