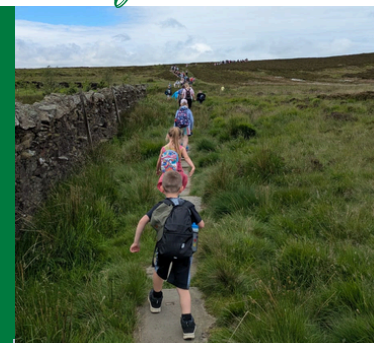
It was truly wonderful to see so many parents and carers joining us along the way. Your support helped make the day even more special, and it was lovely to share such a positive experience together as a school community.
