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| MONDAY | <p>Year 1 - O'clock recap. Mini clocks are in your packs to support all learning on time and use them as you wish. They can help when drawing hands on a clock.</p> <p>Year 2 - O'clock and half past recap worksheet. Be careful with those hands! Use the mini clocks to practice some time work before beginning. This activity is easily extended by asking for x hours later or before on their mini clock.</p> | <p>A Monster Surprise - DON'T READ ME</p> <p>Have a look at the front cover and discuss what you can see. Make some predictions about what you think may happen in the story and why. Write a prediction on the worksheet.</p> <p>Year 1 children will need support with the reading of this text and it can be read to them to complete the weeks work.</p> | <p>Year 1 - Please continue to check through your phonics sounds poster.</p> <p>Ar, ou and oi sounds worksheet.</p> <p>Year 2 - Introduce and Teach activities. Look at and read the words on the sheets. What is the common sound? Discuss the words and find the sound in each of them.</p> | <p>Respecting Rights - presentation on our class page.</p> <p>Look through the presentation and complete the activities and worksheet.</p> |
| TUESDAY | <p>Year 1 - Half past recap worksheets.</p> <p>Year 2 - O'clock and half past with a passage of time worksheet. Be careful with this and use you mini clocks to help you.</p> | <p>Read the first two pages of the story and discuss what you know now. Have a look at the picture on page 1 and discuss what you can see. Write a descriptive paragraph about the rabbit and the settling of the story.</p> | <p>Year 1 - Find the sounds worksheet.</p> <p>Year 2 - Complete the Odd One Out activity.</p> | <p>Year 1 - Teddy Bears reading text. This text is quite challenging, as are the questions so supporting your child with the reading is absolutely fine.</p> <p>Year 2 - Sunflowers read and respond booklet (found at the back of the pack).</p> |
| WEDNESDAY | <p>Year 1 - O'clock and half past recap worksheet.</p> | <p>Year 1 - Fruit Roll reading activity.</p> | <p>Year 1 - Read the words and label the pictures activity.</p> | <p>Protecting our rights presentation online. Look</p> |

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| | Year 2 - Quarter past activity. Again, use the mini clocks to extend this activity as much as you'd like. | Year 2 - Reading booklet 2 found behind sunflower booklet in packs. | Year 2 - Make and write a rhyme activity. Use the words from Monday to make a rhyme. | through the presentation and complete the activities. |
| THURSDAY | <p>Maths</p> <p>Year 1 - O'clock and half past challenge worksheet. Using the mini clocks to work out the passage of time will be very helpful with this task.</p> <p>Year 2 - Quarter past and quarter to worksheet.</p> | <p>Writing</p> <p>Re-read your predictions from Monday. Read the first 2 pages of the story again. Has your prediction changed? Discuss and write and updated prediction based on what you now know.</p> | <p>Phonics</p> <p>Year 1 - Roll and read activity sheet.</p> <p>Year 2 - 'What's my word?' activity from phonics plan. Play the game child v adult.</p> | <p>Arithmetic</p> <p>Year 2 - Complete the addition of 2-digit numbers questions. Who can get them all right? Column addition.</p> |
| FRIDAY | <p>Maths</p> <p>Year 1 - Mental arithmetic activities 1 and 2. These will a good challenge for your child to solve different problems independently. If there are any misconceptions, some time can be spent going through these and doing a little extra practice.</p> <p>Year 2 - Arithmetic Practice worksheets. Be careful and try to make no little mistakes. You can do it!</p> | <p>Writing</p> <p>Question and answers. Read up until the picture show on the worksheet and answer the questions. Year 1's will need help with the reading.</p> | <p>Phonics</p> <p>Year 1 - Spellings.</p> <p>Year 2 - Spellings</p> | <p>Topic</p> <p>Respecting the rights of others - presentation online. Read through and complete the activities.</p> |

- Weekly spellings - test whenever you think is the right time.
- Times table practice.
