Dear Parents/Carers

Re: Class 3 visit to Yorkshire Museum of Farming ~ 11 November 2020

Class 3 will be visiting the Yorkshire Museum of Farming at Murton Park near York on Wednesday 11 November 2020. The children will be participating in a 'Viking Day' which will enable them to experience first-hand the daily life of a Viking family and will support their history topic work.

We have spoken to both the coach company and Murton Park to ensure they are following current government guidance and are risk assessed for the activities we will be undertaking.

The children will spend the day experiencing life in a Viking village and we have been advised that children should come in 'playing out' clothes (eg leggings, tracksuits, hoodies but NO JEANS). Please ensure they also have outerwear and footwear appropriate for the outdoor weather conditions on the day. They will be given a simple period costume to wear on arrival. In the village they will learn new skills and all about the hard work and dangers that were part of life in a Viking settlement.

The total cost of this visit (transport and museum costs) is £926.00. The school is able to contribute £12.00 per child and we are requesting a parental contribution of the remaining **£15.00** to help towards these costs. Payment for this trip is to be made via ParentPay by **Friday 30 October 2020** to enable us to confirm if the trip will be financially viable. No child will be excluded if his or her parents do not contribute, but if insufficient voluntary contributions are received (for this trip, less than 80% of the cost) then regrettably this visit will not go ahead.

Children will need to be in school at 7.50am as the coach will leave school promptly at 8.00am. They will return to school at approximately **4.30pm**. All children will require a packed lunch (no glass bottles please), come dressed as detailed above and ensure they have outerwear and footwear appropriate for the weather conditions on the day.

This visit is not covered by the school's rolling consent form. Please complete the attached Parent Consent Form and email to the school office by **Friday 30 October 2020** to help us with the administration for this visit.
