### Visit from Rabbi Charing ~ Wednesday 28 November 2018





On Wednesday 28 November 2018, we welcomed Rabbi Charing into school, who spent the morning telling the children all about the Jewish festival of Hanukkah.



The children learnt that the festival begins in the evening of Sunday 2 December and ends in the evening of Monday 10 December 2018 and is often referred to as the Festival of Lights. One of the most important symbols is the *hanukkiah or menorah*, which is a 9-branched candelabrum. Some of the children also

learnt how to play 'dreidel', a four-sided spinning top game, which is popular during the Jewish festival. We would like to say a big 'Thank You' to Rabbi Charing for coming into school and delivering such informative sessions to our children.


# Christmas at Keighley Refuge
