

SCHOOL PICK UP ARRANGEMENTS

Please remember to let the school office know if a different family member or friend will be collecting your child from school. School staff can only let children go with a nominated adult if parents/carers cannot pick up for any reason.

A Message from the LSA

THANK YOU to everyone who helped to make the Christmas Fair such a success this year. From planners, helpers, bakers and all who attended, we are so grateful and thoroughly enjoyed seeing so many happy faces on Saturday. The fair raised £1232 (compared with £892 last year) and the raffle raised £1768



(compared with £911 last year)!!! This means the grand total for our Christmas fundraising is an incredible £3000! We cannot thank you all enough!

stages of planning and we will continue to organise events during the rest of the academic year to support the school with this project.


