## Christmas Concert at SCS ~ Tuesday 11 December 2018



## Whole School Visit to Christ Church, Lothersdale ~ Tuesday 18 December 2018

As part of the school's continuing Christmas celebrations, all year groups will be visiting Christ Church, Lothersdale after lunch on Tuesday 18 December 2018. They will be back in time for normal pick up at 3.15pm. Please ensure the children have outdoor wear appropriate for the weather conditions on the day and sturdy school shoes as they will be walking to and from the church.

#### Class Topic Areas for the Spring Term

<u>Class 1</u> ~ will be learning about the cold weather via art and stories and learning about changes in nature - ice, cold, animal tracks, dark evenings and road safety (reflectors and 'be safe be seen' message)

<u>Class 2</u> ~ will be learning about sorting animals, seasonal change and 'who was Neil Armstrong?'

<u>Class 3</u> ~ will be learning about sound and rocks and their topic will be 'transport through the ages'.

<u>Class 4</u> ~ will be learning about World War II, Earth and Space.

#### Class 1 visit to Lotherdale Park and Woods

Yesterday Class 1 went over to Lothersdale Woods with the bird seed cakes they made with Miss Thompson last week. The children put the seed cakes around the woodland area so that the birds will have something to eat over the winter months. Whilst they were there they also spotted blue tits and pheasants.

## Class 1 ~ School Nursing Team Handwashing Session ~ Wednesday 12 December 2018





On Wednesday Class 1 welcomed Jane from the school nursing team, who talked to all the Reception children about the importance of handwashing. They learnt that they need to wash their hands after sneezing, handling pets and using the toilet; before eating and when hands are dirty or muddy. They




also learnt to clean hands properly by using warm water, soap and, most importantly, to ensure hands are dry after washing as germs like wet hands! In school we also use hand gel after drying.

Jane brought along an ultra-violet box and the children put hand gel on their hands, put their hands in the ultra-violet box so they could see the gel on their hands and then washed and dried their hands and put them back in the box to see how well they had washed off the gel.


