Class 3 Swimming Lessons and Swimming Gala Practice (Year 5/6 selected pupils)

Please note that Class 3 swimming lessons will resume on Friday 11 January 2019 and a letter has been sent out via bookbags today for parents/carers of children in Class 3 and Class 4 who have been selected to swim in the Swimming Gala on Friday 18 January. Please ensure those children selected from Class 4 have their swimming kit in school for the practice session on Friday 11 January 2019.

Please note that children in Class 3 and selected children from Class 4 may not arrive back in school until approximately 3.45pm on Friday 11 January 2019. The coach company will be using a larger coach to accommodate those children from Class 4, who will be practicing for the swimming gala, and will therefore have to come through Cross Hills instead of the normal shorter route they usually take to avoid that area. 

School Office and Updates

School Meal Menu ~ Spring Term 2019

Next term's school meal menu is attached to this newsletter for your information. Please note that Mrs Varley has made some amendments to this menu and it can also be viewed on the school website.

Pupils on Pack Ups ~ Friday Lunch

If your child is currently on pack-ups and is registered to have a Friday lunch next term, the cost will be £31.72 for the spring term (up to and including 12 April 2019), payable via the normal pupil meal account on ParentPay, or £2.44 per week, payable in advance. Please ensure you inform the school office at least 2 weeks in advance if your child would like to have Friday lunches.

Pupils on Packed Lunches

May we remind parents to ensure their child's pack up is clearly named to help us distribute at lunchtime. Many thanks.

School Meals ~ Class 3 and Class 4

The cost of school meals for children in Class 3 and Class 4 from 8 January 2019 will continue to be £2.44 per meal (£12.20 per week) for all children.

For parents/carers who wish to pay up to the end of term (Friday 12 April 2019), the cost will be £156.16 per child payable via ParentPay.

For parents/carers who wish to pay up to the end of half-term (Friday 22 February 2019), the cost will be £82.96 per child payable via ParentPay.

Alternatively, parents/carers can pay weekly (£12.20) via ParentPay.

Please note that school meals $\underline{\text{must}}$ be paid for in advance and we would also ask parents/carers to refer to the school's School Meals' Arrears Procedure (available to view on the school website) to ensure that you are familiar with the school's course of action should you find yourselves falling behind with payments.

Please check your ParentPay accounts for credits/outstanding payments (eg illness, educational visits etc) and adjust your child's account accordingly when paying the above.

Eligibility for Free School Meals

May we remind parents that free school meals are available for children whose parents/carers meet the relevant criteria. If you are in receipt of one or more of the following benefits and think you may qualify, please either ask Mrs Ellison for an application form or use the application form available via www.northyorks.gov.uk/freeschoolmeals.

The relevant criteria is based on receipt of:

- income support
- income-based job seeker's allowance
- income-related employment and support allowance
- child tax credit with an income of less than £16,190 and not in receipt of working tax credit
- support under part VI of the immigration and asylum act 1999
- guarantee element of state pension credit.

Where parents are entitled to working tax credit during a four week "run on" period immediately after their employment has ceased, or after they have started to work less than 16 hours per week, their children are entitled to free school meals.

Children who receive income support or income based jobseeker's allowance in their own right are also entitled to free school meals.

Applications are usually processed the same day. If your child is entitled to free school meals you will receive a letter confirming the date when the meals will start. The school is also notified that your child is entitled to free school meals.

In the meantime, you should continue to pay for school meals until confirmation comes through. Schools may be able to arrange a reimbursement of any monies paid whilst your entitlement is being confirmed. If you are not entitled to free school meals you will be notified in writing.

May we remind parents that the deadline for payment of contributions towards the pantomime performance was <u>Friday 7</u> <u>December 2018</u>. If you have not already made a contribution and would still like to do so, please make your payment via ParentPay. The school has now received 81% of contributions to date but still needs

at least 85% to make it financially viable. No child will be excluded if his or her parents/carers do not contribute, but if insufficient voluntary contributions are received then regrettably we will have to cancel this performance.

Primary School Admissions ~ September 2019

Online applications are currently being made via the Local Authority for reception places at Lothersdale Primary School for September 2019. The online common application form must be submitted by no later than <u>15 January 2019</u>. If you are the parent/carer of a child, or know of a child, who is eligible to start primary school next September and whose name is not on the school's register of interest, please contact the school as soon as possible.


Next tree planting meet up Wednesday 2nd January 2019!
