We have all had a very busy term leading up to Christmas and now hope all our families (and staff) have a wonderful Christmas break.

### Message from Mrs Tyson

Dear Parents, Carers and Pupils

As we approach the end of this term, I would like to take a moment to reflect on the incredible journey we have undertaken together over the past few months. It has been a time filled with growth, achievements, and the spirit of unity that defines our school community.

First and foremost, I would like to express my deepest gratitude to our dedicated teachers, support staff, and, of course, our amazing pupils. Your hard work, enthusiasm, and resilience have made this term a success. Together, we have faced challenges, celebrated victories, and continued to uphold the values that make our school special.

I would like to update you on how some of our school development priorities have advanced during this first term:

#### 1. Teaching and Learning

- Staff have adopted new curriculums for Geography, History, PSHE and the Arts. The impact of this
  is already evident, as children are engaged with their learning and demonstrating positive
  outcomes.
- The English curriculum has been rewritten and rolled out across school. All classes now use high quality texts to steer the teaching of English. This has been a great success so far, as we have seen significant improvements within writing outcomes.
- Parents and carers now receive printed copies of each curriculum overview, a class newsletter and core knowledge organisers, at the start of each new unit.

#### 2. Targeted Academic Support

- Assessment procedures have been introduced and tightened to ensure that the progress of each child is effectively monitored and addressed accordingly.
- Pupil Progress reviews are conducted half termly.
- 'Point of Need' interventions introduced: all support staff work flexibly across school to support teaching staff to deliver same day interventions, allowing misconceptions to be addressed and gaps in understanding to be narrowed.

#### 3. Wider Strategies

- Cultural capital curriculum introduced: all staff plan for immersive, enriching opportunities to compliment the existing curriculum. Each class receives a school trip or school visitor, each half term.
- Pupils' personal development is championed through the new PSHE curriculum, themed curriculum days and pupil voice groups, such as school council.
- Appointment of a 'Poet-in-residence' to enhance study of the arts.

As we move into the new term, there will be greater focus on the following areas:

- Continued monitoring of curriculum and pupil outcomes in reading, writing and maths.
- Development of outdoor provision for EYFS and KS1.
- Launch of 'Nessy', 'Precision Teaching' and 'Clicker 8' programmes to support children with specific learning needs.
- Introduce metacognitive practice as part of a 'Lothersdale Behaviour for Learning' curriculum.

I am excited to embark on these projects and update you on the progress of these at the end of the Spring term.

As we eagerly anticipate the Christmas break, I want to extend my warmest wishes to each and every one of you. May this festive season bring joy, love, and peace to your homes. It is a time to cherish the company of loved ones, reflect on the year gone by, and look forward to the possibilities that the new year holds.

For our pupils, take this opportunity to recharge your energy, explore new interests, and spend quality time with family and friends.

To our parents and carers, thank you for your unwavering support throughout the year. Your partnership is invaluable, and we are grateful for the trust you place in us to nurture and educate your children.

As we bid farewell to 2023, let's approach the new year with optimism, determination, and a commitment to making it even more successful than the last. Our journey together continues, and I am excited about the possibilities that the future holds for our school community.

On behalf of the entire school staff, I wish you a Merry Christmas and a happy New Year. May the coming year be filled with prosperity, good health, and countless moments of happiness.

Enjoy a well-deserved break, and we look forward to welcoming everyone back refreshed and ready for another exciting term.




