Thank you to Alan Weekes for his time and excellent and informative Online Safety Presentation on Wednesday and to those parents/carers who were able to attend.

All parents/carers who attended found the session really useful and enlightening and left with a greater understanding of the dangers that our children face and will face as they get older; they also left armed with good advice that will help them support their children as they navigate the online world. There was a lot of information given that I wasn't aware of and it will certainly make me think about things differently going forward.

An engaging, informative and interactive presentation. Alan summarised that while the hazards of the web and online communications can seem daunting, we as parents should remember to treat them as we have any other hazard during our child's development around the home, near roads etc ... patiently, incrementally, and with guidance. 
