Could you help save a life?

The Lothersdale Community First Responders, (CFR) team is a group of volunteers who work with the Yorkshire Ambulance Service, (YAS) to provide a response to certain 999 calls were we can reach the patient before the ambulance can arrive and provide assistance to the patient whilst waiting for the paramedics to get on scene.



All CFR's are trained by YAS in CPR, use of a defibrillator and patient care, the Lothersdale group operates within a 5 mile radius of the centre of the village. Meetings are held 5 times a year to keep training up to date and to be appraised of updates to procedures.

All time given to the scheme is voluntary and at a time of your choosing, going on call is just a phone call to the centre and you can stay on call as long as is practical for you.
