SCHOOL PICK UP ARRANGEMENTS

Please remember to let the school office know if a different family member or friend will be collecting your child from school. School staff can only let children go with a nominated adult if parents/carers cannot pick up for any reason.

NORTH YORKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL ROAD CLOSURE Monday 5 February to Friday 16 February 2024

You will have seen from the signage displayed at the bottom of Lothersdale Road coming into Cross Hills, that the road is due to be closed from Sunday 4 February to Friday 16 February 2024 and diversions will be in place.

As this is one of the main routes into the village, and the closure will impact both villagers and school traffic, we have contacted North Yorkshire County Council to confirm if the road will be permanently closed during this period, or open between certain hours. They have confirmed the route will be blocked off and only emergency vehicles will be allowed through.

The works being carried out are repairs to the drainage systems. These systems are critical in draining rainfall from the road surface for the safety of road users and longevity of the road surface. The drainage works will consist of new drainage pipe / new drainage system installation or the repair of existing drainage systems.

The road closure will have an impact on school traffic from 5 February to 9 February prior to half-term. Please therefore allow more time during this period whilst following an alternative route to school.

This offer benefits nature and for the farm, like water storage (less flooding in winter, less drought in summer) and better water quality (cooler & cleaner) as well as providing shelterbelts for the livestock from wind and sun and more mixed forage.
