

header to help us identify the replies easily. Activities will be allocated on a first come first serve basis.

PAID Clubs: the deadline for payment for children taking part in paying clubs is <u>Wednesday 8 February</u> 2023 to enable your child to continue with his/her chosen club. Your child's name will only be entered on the activity lists once payment has been made. The extended schools' accounts will be removed from ParentPay once the deadline has passed so it is important that payments are made promptly.

All extended schools' activities finish on Friday 31 March 2023 and children should be collected from school at the normal time of 3.15pm week commencing 27 March 2023.

The activity lists will be available on Thursday 9 February. *Please note that we are unable to add your child to an activity list once the deadline has passed and the lists have been distributed to providers and LOOSC. It is therefore important that you help us to avoid your child missing out on an activity by adhering to the stated deadline.*

key message 'Want to talk about it? Making space for conversations about life online'. Its aim is to promote the safe, responsible and positive use of digital technology for children and young people.

National Online Safety ~ Encouraging open discussions about digital safety

One of the most eye-catching results of a survey conducted by National Online Safety last year (taking in more than 1,000 UK parents and carers) was that more than one in six -18% - never talk to their child about staying safe online. There are many quite understandable reasons for this, such as feeling that their child is still too young, or assuming that they're being taught online safety at school.

The fact remains, however, that regular conversations about our digital lives can help children keep online safety firmly in mind and avoid many common internet hazards.

We attach this week's National Online Safety guide, which has some ideas for starting these beneficial chats with children – letting them know that you're taking a keen interest without making it feel like an interrogation.

LSA Supermarket Bag Packing Fundraiser ~ Saturday 11 February 2023


