



Snacks

All children in Class 1 and Class 2 are provided with a free piece of fruit every day as a government



initiative, which is eaten outside at breaktime. The LSA (Lothersdale School Association) kindly fund the provision of fruit twice a week for children in Class 3 and Class 4. <u>Please</u> note that children can also bring a **fruit or veg snack** from home if they wish - no other food items are allowed in school for snack eg. chocolate, crisps, yoghurt, wraps, etc. This should be kept in your child's bookbag to be taken outside at breaktime. We thank you for your support in keeping our children healthy.

School Water Bottles



This is to remind parents/carers that children must bring to school a <u>named school water bottle</u>. Water bottles can be filled at school and will remain on your child's desk or in their SmartSack throughout the day. They will be sent home with your child at the end of the school day for washing. <u>Please note that, in line with our uniform policy, no other</u>

<u>water bottles should be brought into school</u>. If your child does not currently have a school water bottle, then please ensure you order one through ParentPay by Tuesday morning (20 September) so that we can pass to your child in class ready for the school day. Thank you for your support.

We can confirm, following our text on Thursday, that this trip will go ahead as planned. Our target of 85% voluntary contributions has been met – only just. We would like to thank those parents/carers who kindly offered to cover the shortfall the school would incur due to the receipt of insufficient voluntary contributions for this trip. It was a very kind gesture and wholly appreciated by the school. Thankfully, in this instance, your support was not required, but we will be reviewing the way we manage all our future trips to ensure that, when the school does not receive sufficient funds by the stated deadline, the school does not incur charges when cancelling future trips.



We are all very excited about our trip to Murton Park next Friday, 23 September 2022. Please arrive at the main school gate at 7.50am to be met by a member of staff. <u>The coach will leave school promptly at 8.00am</u>. They will return to school at approximately **4.30pm**.

If your child suffers with travel sickness, please ensure they take a tablet before they arrive in the morning and send another for the return journey; please place this in an envelope detailing their name and any specific instructions, and hand this to a member of staff on

arrival at school. Please inform a member of staff if your child has taken a tablet before arriving at school on Friday morning.

Pack ups will be provided to those children who normally have a school lunch (*please ensure you have indicated the school meal option on SchoolGrid for Friday's lunch as normal*). Children currently on packed lunches should bring in their packed lunch (no glass bottles please).

Children should come dressed as evacuees. It is suggested that girls wear a dark coloured skirt/pinafore and jumper or cardigan and long socks and boys wear dark coloured shorts, shirt and tank top or jumper, long socks and a flat cap. They should also wear sturdy sensible school shoes and outerwear appropriate for the weather conditions on the day, as some of the day will be spent outdoors.

In the event that there is a delay on the return journey, we will keep parents/carers up-to-date via the text message system. If your child is booked into Lothersdale Out of School Club, please ensure staff are aware that he/she needs to be brought round to school at 7.50am on Friday morning.

ParentPay Adjustments

We are still working on adjustments/refunds from the school meal module. Please note that if a refund has been made, the money will go onto your ParentPay account and not directly back into your bank account. ParentPay has advised us that parents/carers can move money back into a bank account from the ParentPay account by using the withdraw function.

SchoolGrid Menu

There has been some confusion this week regarding the school menu and vegetarian food. Please note that the school menu is as per the menu currently available on the school website and in last week's Friday News.

Meat is served and not a vegetarian substitute (unless your child is on our list of dietary requirements and receives the vegetarian option), so please disregard the (VG) against a meal option if your child has school dinners.

As stated in our newsletter last week, we are working with Dolce to ensure the menu on the SchoolGrid system is representative of the Lothersdale School menu and not the generic Dolce menu.

<u>Note:</u> Parents/carers cannot choose a meal one day and a pack up the next day ~ our kitchen system is not designed for this as the food is ordered in advance.
