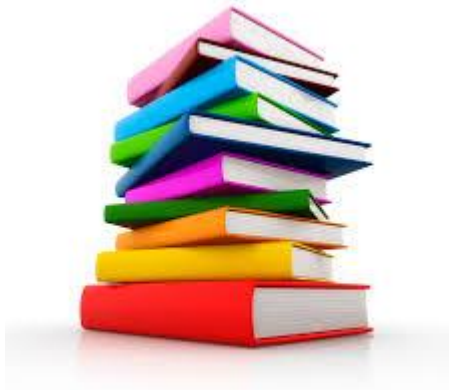
Tag Rugby

Chinese New Year and Internet Safety Day

We participated in a fun and informative Chinese New Year dance workshop on Monday afternoon, learning that dragons, which are legendary animals, are important to Chinese people who view them as helpful, friendly creatures. They are linked to good luck, long life and wisdom and are nothing like the fierce, fire-breathing Western dragons that we are familiar with! Chinese Dragons are associated with storm clouds and life-giving rain, having special powers enabling them to fly in the air, swim in the sea and walk on land. With this in mind, we used a dragon puppet in our Chinese New Year dance to scare away any evil spirits and bring us good luck for the year.

In addition to this, we have taken part in 'Safer Internet Day' workshops, in which we have been learning about using technology responsibly, respectfully, critically and creatively. Particular focus has been given to how consent works in an online context, asking the children to consider how they ask, give, and receive consent online. We have studied how the internet works, who owns the information that is shared on it, and how children can actively take ownership of digital spaces.
