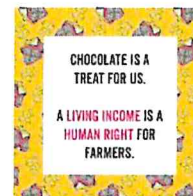
World Book Day ~ Thursday 7 March 2019

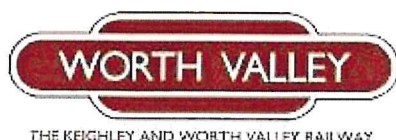
Fairtrade Fortnight ~ 25 February to 10 March 2019 ~ Fairtrade Packaging

PAEDIATRIC FIRST AID COURSE ~ INVITATION FOR PARENTS

Stepping Stones Nursery & Out of School Club (Cononley) is running a 1-day Paediatric First Aid course on Wednesday 20 March 2019 and they are offering to other local schools, nurseries, community groups and parents/carers. If you don't feel the course is appropriate for you but you know someone who may be interested, please forward this information on to them (i.e. friends, family, work colleagues).

The cost per delegate is £35, and the course will take place at Cononley Institute from 9:00am until 3:30pm.

The course will be run by Martin Wiseman (Senior Charge Nurse, Emergency Department @ Airedale Hospital), who is an accredited Paediatric First Aid (PFA) trainer. All delegates will receive a Full PFA certificate that is valid for 3 years. The course covers the entire content of the full 2-day PFA course, but is delivered in a more intensive format over 1 day instead of 2. It includes practical work and delegates will be assessed prior to obtaining their certificate. The programme will cover all topics as laid out in Annexe A of the EYFS Statutory Guidelines:

Being able to assess an emergency situation and prioritise what action to take;

How to help a child who is unresponsive and breathing normally;

How to help a child who is unresponsive and not breathing normally;

How to help a child in the following situations:

- having a seizure;
- choking;
- bleeding;
- shock caused by severe blood loss (hypovolemic shock);
- anaphylactic shock;
- electric shock;
- burns or scalds;
- a suspected fracture;
- head, neck or back injuries;
- suspected of being poisoning;
- foreign body in eyes, ears or nose;
- eye injuries;
- bites or stings;
- suffering from the effects of extreme heat or cold;
- diabetic emergency;
- asthma attack;
- allergic reactions;
- meningitis and febrile convulsions;

Role and responsibilities of the paediatric first aider (including appropriate contents of a first aid box and the need for recording accidents and incidents)

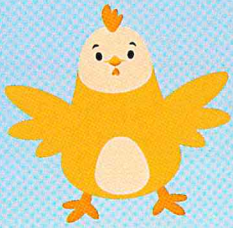

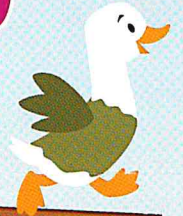
