#### Health & Safety Update!

#### Hygiene in School

We are currently setting up further preventative hygiene measures in school following Coronavirus updates from the DfE and Public Health England. On Tuesday, a whole school assembly was held to highlight to all the children the importance of regular handwashing and sanitizing. Mrs Bateman demonstrated how to handwash with her helpers, Jack S and Rose B, who both remembered to use warm water to wash their hands and nails thoroughly with soap, to dry then fully and to add our school anti-bacterial hand foam. We watched two short video clips from CBBC Newsround and the CBBC doctor explained Coronavirus in simple, child appropriate language. Top Tip: sing 'Happy Birthday' twice as you wash your hands to make sure they are clean.

It is essential that all children keep hydrated throughout the day and use their own water bottle to prevent cross contamination. Please therefore ensure that your child brings a school water bottle to school on Monday as not all children have a water bottle in school. If you do not have a school water bottle, or your child's current water bottle needs replacing, please order one via ParentPay. Many thanks for your support.

#### Extended Schools ~ Picking Up ~ Safeguarding

The children had a wonderful time talking about the books that had inspired their creations!




















#### Sport Relief ~ Friday 13 March 2020

Class 1 Fire Safety Workshop ~ Monday 2 March 2020










Fran and Robbie from Craven Fire and Rescue came into school on Monday to talk to Class 1 about the role of a firefighter and how they help our community.









### KS2 Art Club - session 2


