I cannot quite believe that we are very nearly at the end of term; just one more week in school and then you can have your children all to yourselves again for two whole weeks. At least this time you don't have to do any home schooling! I think the children will have earned a break by then, and I just hope the sun shines and we are all able to get out and about a little.

This week we have been assessing the children to help us decide what areas we should be focussing on in the summer term. One thing we will certainly be doing is ensuring that the children still receive a broad and balanced curriculum with plenty of opportunities for creative subjects such as art and design technology as well as the usual access to quality music, language and PE teaching.

At the end of term, we would normally organise a parents' evening, however, as we have not seen so much of the majority of the children this term, I decided to wait until early in the summer term. This will give us chance to assess where the children are at, both formally through summative testing, and also informally through chatting to them in the classroom and on the playground. This way, the teachers will have a much better idea of areas that the children need to focus on during the final term of the year. We will notify you early in the summer term about the date and format of the parental consultation. We will then send full written reports toward the end of the summer term, in July.




