#### Swimming Lessons ~ Voluntary Contributions



Please note that the deadline for payment of voluntary contributions towards your child's Class 2 swimming lessons was <u>Monday 18 March 2024</u>. Swimming is an important part of the curriculum but, unfortunately, the school receives no extra funding for swimming and relies on parental contributions to enable the children to take part in this activity.

Sadly, the school is £175.50 short of the total required to make this Class 2 activity financially viable and, along with the £768.40 shortfall from the Class 3 swimming lessons, the school must now take £943.90 from the curriculum budget to make up this loss. As this shortfall has not been accounted for in this year's budget, it may mean that, sadly, some planned curriculum projects will now have to be cancelled.

The payments for both Class 2 and Class 3 remain open on School Gateway if you have not yet made a contribution (however small), and still wish to do so.

#### **School Uniform**

We have noticed a growing number of children coming to school in clothes that are not part of our school uniform this term. Please note that personal water bottles, leggings, sports socks, coloured socks/tights and trainers are <u>not</u> part of the current school uniform.

We would be grateful if all parents/carers could take the time over the Easter break to ensure the school uniform (and PE kit) complies with the official school uniform policy.

Please note that trainers of any kind are not classed as school shoes, nor are black boots. Straps on bookbags must be removed for health and safety reasons for children in Class 1 and Class 2.

#### School Water Bottles

Please ensure all children bring a school water bottle to school in line with the school's policy. No other water bottles are permitted. Please note that, once the current supply of school water bottles runs out, we will be offering an alternative school water bottle via School Gateway. Trials have taken place and we have been assured they do not leak!

PLEASE CLEARLY LABEL <u>ALL</u> SCHOOL UNIFORM WITH YOUR CHILD'S NAME. WE WOULD ASK YOU TO USE IRON-ON OR SEWN-IN LABELS AND NOT MARKER PEN/BALLPOINT PEN AS THIS RUBS OFF VERY QUICKLY AND MAKES IT DIFFICULT TO IDENTIFY CLOTHING ITEMS.

All the uniform items are readily available from Skip to School, Water Street, Skipton.

#### LEGENDS Before & After School Club ~ Fee Increase

From 1 April 2024, our LEGENDS fees will increase as detailed below. The SchoolGateway system will be updated early next week, and parents/carers will be able to book Breakfast and/or the After School Club sessions for the summer term onwards, from Wednesday 27 March 2024.

**Legends Breakfast Club** (7:30am – 8:40am) is £7.14 per child per session including a light snack and drink.

**Legends Afternoon Full Session** (3:15pm – 6:00pm) is £11.29 per child per session including a light snack and drink.

**Legends Afternoon Short Session** (3:15pm – 4:30pm) is £5.88 per child per session (please note this does not include a light snack).

**Legends Afternoon Short Session** (4:15pm – 6:00pm) is £7.88 per child per session including a light snack and drink.
