Health & Safety Updates

The Woodland Area

The woodland area of the playground is out of bounds to all children unless directed by a member of staff during the school day.

There have been reports of children playing in this area after school and we would therefore remind all parents/carers that this is not in use before school, or after school finishes at 3.15pm, due to health and safety considerations. We thank you all for your support in helping to keep your children safe.

Update on Managing Covid in Schools

Respiratory infections are common in children and young people, particularly during the winter months. Symptoms can be caused by several respiratory infections including the common cold, COVID-19 and RSV.

For most children and young people, these illnesses will not be serious, and they will soon recover following rest and plenty of fluids.

Very few children and young people with respiratory infections become seriously unwell. This is also true for children and young people with long-term conditions.

Attending education is hugely important for children and young people's health and their future.

When children with symptoms should stay at home and when they can return to education


Children with mild symptoms such as a runny nose, sore throat, or slight cough, who are otherwise well, can continue to attend their education setting.

Children and young people who are unwell and have a high temperature should stay at home and avoid contact with other people, where they can. They can go back to school and resume normal activities when they no longer have a high temperature, and they are well enough to attend.

All children and young people with respiratory symptoms should be encouraged to cover their mouth and nose with a disposable tissue when coughing and/or sneezing and to wash their hands after using or disposing of tissues.

Lothersdale Primary School will continue with our current control measures to prevent the spread of infections and we will update our Risk Assessment when we receive updated guidance from NYCC.

Year 6 ~ Bikeability (Cycle Training) ~ May 2022

Just a reminder that Year 6 will be taking part in Bikeability sessions on Wednesday 25 and Thursday 27 May 2022. They will need to have a bike in good working order and suitable for riding on the road. Helmets are also compulsory. Please take the opportunity over the Easter break to make sure your child’s bike is safe to ride. An M Check sheet is included below, which details what you need to check to ensure the bike is safe. This can also be viewed on the class website. Further details and consent will be issued after the Easter holiday.

Helmet Check

Ensure helmets fit tightly around the circumference of the head and the strap is secure below the chin, with enough room for two fingers between the strap and the chin.

Bike Check

Before you set off on any ride, check all bikes in the group are in good working order. Remember your ABC: A – air, B – brakes, C – chain.

- Brakes – check the front brake by rolling the bike forward and applying the brake. The bike should stop quickly. Ensure you can fit two fingers between the brake lever and handlebar. Roll the bike backwards to check the rear brake.
- Tyres – squeeze the sidewall of the tyre to check the air pressure. There should be no give and the tyre should feel solid.

ParentPay Accounts

Please ensure that all ParentPay accounts are up-to-date and a zero or credit balance remains on school meal accounts when school closes today, Friday 8 April 2022.

Pupils on Pack Ups ~ Friday Lunch

If your child is currently on pack-ups and is registered to have a Friday lunch next term, the cost will be £29.28 for the summer term (up to and including 22 July 2022), payable via the normal pupil meal account on ParentPay, or £2.44 per week, payable in advance. Please ensure you inform the school office at least 2 weeks in advance if your child would like to have Friday lunches.

Pupils on Packed Lunches

May we remind parents to ensure their child's pack up is clearly named and that you give the school office at least two week's term-time notice if your child would like to switch to school meals or vice versa.

School Meals ~ Class 3 and Class 4

The cost of school meals for children in Class 3 and Class 4 from 26 April 2022 will continue to be £2.44 per meal (£12.20 per week) for all children.

For parents/carers who wish to pay up to the end of term (Friday 22 July 2022), the cost will be £139.08 per child payable via ParentPay.

For parents/carers who wish to pay up to the end of half-term (Friday 27 May 2022), the cost will be £56.12 per child payable via ParentPay.

Alternatively, parents/carers can pay weekly in advance (£12.20) via ParentPay. Please note that school meals must be paid for in advance and we would also ask parents/carers to refer to the school's School Meals' Arrears Procedure (available to view on the school website) to ensure that you are familiar with the school's course of action should you find yourselves falling behind with payments.

Please check your ParentPay accounts for credits/outstanding payments (eg illness, educational visits etc) and adjust your child's account accordingly when paying the above.

Eligibility for Free School Meals

We would like to remind parents that free school meals are available for children whose parents meet the relevant criteria. If you are in receipt of one or more of the following benefits and think you may qualify, please either ask Mrs Ellison for an application form or use the application form available via www.northyorks.gov.uk/freeschoolmeals

The relevant criteria is based on receipt of:


- income support
- income-based job seeker's allowance
- income-related employment and support allowance
- child tax credit with an income of less than £16,190 and **not** in receipt of working tax credit
- support under part VI of the immigration and asylum act 1999
- guarantee element of state pension credit.

Where parents are entitled to working tax credit during a four week "run on" period immediately after their employment has ceased, or after they have started to work less than 16 hours per week, their children are entitled to free school meals. Children who receive income support or income-based jobseeker's allowance in their own right are also entitled to free school meals.

Applications are usually processed the same day. If your child is entitled to free school meals you will receive a letter confirming the date when the meals will start.

The school is also notified that your child is entitled to free school meals. In the meantime, you should continue to pay for free school meals until confirmation comes through. School may be able to arrange a reimbursement of any monies paid whilst your entitlement is being confirmed. If you are not entitled to free school meals you will be notified in writing.






