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Y3-4 Maths Challenge at South Craven School ~ Wednesday 26 April 2023

Huge congratulations to our eight mathematicians from Class 3 ~ Emily, Ella H, Penny, Annabelle J, Niamh, Joe, Charlotte and Lucie ~ who joined eight other local schools for this year's Maths Challenge at South Craven School on Wednesday. The children worked extremely well in three challenges.

<u>Challenge 1 – Problem Solving</u>: the children had to work together to solve different word problems. Different questions were worth different points. **A** questions were worth 5 points, **B** questions were 10 points and **C** questions were worth 20 points. Overall, the team worked well together to achieve 125 points and received an extra 10 points for working so well as a team!

<u>Challenge 2 ~ Relay</u>: the children had to answer questions for a piece of a jigsaw puzzle. They again had to work as a team to solve the answer and build the puzzle.

<u>Challenge 3 ~ Construction</u>: the children had to use paper straws and paper clips to build a high tower to hold a heavy cube. STEM club participants shared their ideas of using triangles to make a strong base. Our tower only measured 35cm, however it was very sturdy. Unfortunately, our model didn't

support the weight but again the children worked really well together.

Towards the end of the Maths Challenge, the children were a little deflated that their model didn't work properly. However, during the reward ceremony, we were delighted to learn we had come second place! Mrs Knight was extremely proud of them all. Well done everyone!





Class 3 visit to Cliffe Castle ~ Thursday 27 April 2023

Class 3 had a wonderful trip to Cliffe Castle yesterday to enhance their learning for our Stone Age history topic.

All children listened well to Pippa, our workshop leader, and taught them about the historical timelines of the Stone Age, Bronze Age and Iron Age as well as the Romans, Victorians and modern day periods of history. Afterwards, the children had to place the periods in chronological order.

The children rotated around three areas:

 Looking into how archaeologists excavate to find artefacts and how they would classify them into the historical periods.

- Looking at real artefacts from the Bronze Age.
- Looking at the Mesolithic era from the Stone Age and what implements they would have used in everyday life.

During the afternoon, the children were able to make their own Stone Age and Bronze Age axes, learnt how difficult it is for archaeologists to piece together segments of artefacts and use the timeline from the Stone Age to Iron Age to identify a range of artefacts within the museum.

What a wonderful day everyone had! Mrs Knight was very proud of all the children. Thank you to Mrs Gallagher and placement students, Megan and Nancy, who supported Mrs Knight and Mrs Neil on this visit.

The Great Tit Family



Just a few reminders about the SchoolGrid system.



- Please support the school kitchen by ensuring you have booked school meals via SchoolGrid, particularly following a weekend or holiday, by 8.55am. On Tuesday we had 20 children who had not been booked on to the SchoolGrid system and this was despite a text reminder on Monday. Our cook is in school first thing in a morning and she relies on the booking system to prepare the food orders.
- There is now no notice period for children wishing to switch school lunch options. Children have the option to have school dinners and/or pack ups on a daily basis. If your child normally has school dinners and would like to start having packed lunches (daily or ad-hoc), please drop us an email so that we can manage the system accordingly.
