Breaktime Snacks

May we remind parents/carers that **sweets and chocolate are not allowed in school (this also applies to children on school visits/residentials)** as part of the Healthy School initiative.

Children may bring **fruit/veg** to eat at morning break. All children in Key Stage 1 are provided with a free piece of fruit every day as a government initiative. Each Friday is 'Fruit Friday' where bringing fruit, fresh, dried etc. is particularly encouraged. The LSA (Lothersdale School Association) kindly fund the provision of fruit twice a week for children in KS2 (Years 3, 4, 5 & 6).



All our children have also been reminded, through our Healthy School assemblies, that they can bring a piece of fruit or veg to eat at breaktime as a snack.

No other food items are allowed – if your child is bringing a pack up lunch, please ensure it also does not contain any foods containing nuts.

We understand that birthdays are special occasions and parents/carers may want to send in something for their child to share with the class, like packs of Haribos. In this instance, we would only give out the sweets at the end of the school day so that parents can decide if they want their children to have them. This is particularly important as we have children with allergies in school.
