Transition Information

- There will also be opportunities in our Sustainability Week for the children to work with their new teachers.

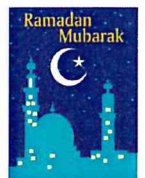

'Let's Celebrate ~ Ramadan' Week



This week all the children in school learnt about the Muslim festival, Ramadan. The younger children learnt key facts including that Muslims would be fasting during Ramadan and that meant they could only eat after sunset and before sunrise. Muslims use this period of fasting for prayer and reflection. Class 1 decorated some Islamic patterns and also shared a snack of fruit and raisins and thought how they would feel if they



couldn't eat during the day.

Class 2 created their own patterns using collage materials and Class 3 have watched some videos showing Muslim families explaining about the importance and meaning of Ramadan and Eid. They have also been making colourful Islamic patterns on squared paper. Class 4 have held discussions and worked through a PowerPoint about this special Islamic festival.

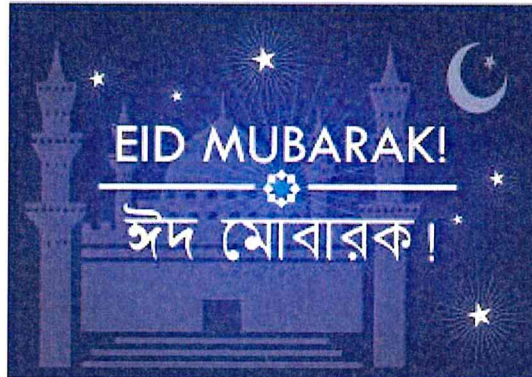

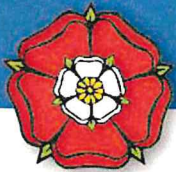
