Y5/6 Forensic Science Event at South Craven School ~ Wednesday 24 May 2023

Mrs Bateman and Miss Baker would like to thank our team of scientists from Class 4 – Archie, Chloe Di, William, Felicity, Tess, Chloe P, Ernie, Matilda, Natty and Chloe Dr - who took part in the Forensic Science event at South Craven School this week. The team of 10 pupils had to use forensic techniques to gather evidence and solve a crime. The evidence included looking at hair fibres through microscopes, comparing soil samples and testing chemicals in Bunsen burners! They all made very convincing detectives. It was a pleasure to work with the group who displayed great team work and exemplary manners and behaviour throughout.

Year 6 Bikeability ~ 22 & 23 May 2023

All our Year 6 children worked extremely hard to achieve their Level 2 Bikeability award on Monday and Tuesday this week and we are all very proud of our Year 6 children as they copied with the warm weather over the two-day training session.

The training recognised that they are able to: prepare for on-road cycling, start and finish an on-road journey, recognise typical hazards, let others know what they are about to do, pass parked vehicles and side roads, turn into and out of side roads and understand the Highway Code. Thank you to the instructors from Go Velo for all their support and encouragement over the two days.

Parent Governor Vacancies

A letter and accompanying documentation was emailed to all parents/carers on Friday 19 May 2023 regarding nominations for two parent governors.

The Local Governing Body is delegated certain functions by the YCAT Board. The LGB is responsible for the conduct of the school and promoting high standards in all areas of school life. It is the role of the Local Governing Body to ensure equality of access for pupils and staff, to hold the Headteacher to

account for the educational performance of the children, oversee the school's budget and ensure money is well spent.

Parent governors are not elected to represent their stakeholder group but are elected in order to contribute to the work of the LGB. Parent governors are a representative parent, not elected to represent parents.

Final nominations need to be received in school by <u>Friday 9 June 2023</u> so that the Governors can determine whether they need to hold an election.

This event is kindly being sponsored by local company, JN Bentley, who will give each participating child their initial £1 during a special assembly.



School Attendance



Lothersdale Primary School expect children to attend school every day, as long as they are fit and healthy to do so. Punctuality is also important. School starts at 8.45am each morning and your child must arrive on time to ensure they are in class when the register is taken.

Anything less than 100% attendance means that your child is missing out on their education.

Did you know that 90% attendance is the same as missing half a day each week, or one month a year off school?

Did you know that being just five minutes late each morning means that your child would miss the equivalent of three days from school each year?

This half-term, the class with the best attendance is Class 2.
