Mrs Aldren was very impressed with the children's behaviour and their enthusiasm when undertaking each allocated task. They looked at hair under a microscope, fingerprinting and used a Bunsen Burner to help solve some of the clues. Well done everyone!

Year 6 Bikeability ~ 25 & 26 May 2022

All our Year 6 children worked extremely hard to achieve their Level 2 Bikeability award on Wednesday and Thursday this week.

We are all very proud of our Year 6 children as they battled through the wet weather over the two-day training session, some of which had to be continued indoors due to the appalling conditions.



The training recognised that they are able to: prepare for on-road cycling, start and finish an on-road journey, recognise typical hazards, let others know what they are about to do, pass parked vehicles and side roads, turn into and out of side roads and understand the Highway Code. The instructors were very complimentary about all of the children, commenting on how carefully they listened and completed everything that was asked of them to a high standard.

Y5/6 North Yorkshire Girls' Cricket Competition ~ Tuesday 7 June 2022



The extended schools' accounts will be removed from ParentPay once the deadline has passed so it is important that payments are made promptly.



All extended schools' activities finish during the week ending Friday 15 July 2022. The activity lists will be available to view on the school website by close of play on Monday 6 June 2022.

Please note that we are unable to add your child to an activity list once the deadline has passed and the lists have been distributed to providers and LOOSC. It is therefore important that you help us to avoid your child missing out on an activity by adhering to the stated deadline.




The Great Tit Family Update

On Monday our chicks were huge and the nest box looked very cramped as they jostled with each other and tried out their wings.

By Tuesday a couple of the chicks were definitely ready to fledge and by Wednesday morning one had already gone when school opened up and another three soon followed, leaving five remaining in the nest box. By Wednesday evening, four chicks were left.

On Thursday morning Mrs Bateman and Mrs Ellison switched on the screen to find two chicks remaining with mummy bird still flitting in and out with food but, within 20 minutes, they too had flown off leaving the nest box looking very sad and empty. Fingers crossed we will get another family of Great Tits next year!
