Hello everyone!

Welcome back for the last half term of the year, after what was hopefully a super holiday week in the sunshine! I can report that pupils have returned to their learning with enthusiasm this week and it has been lovely to see them all enjoying the fantastic new playground markings during their sunny break times, including taking up the challenge of running the mile circuit! Huge thanks to the LSA for organising and fundraising for this.

This week it was great to be able to spend a day in school working with our new head teacher-to-be, Mrs Tyson. She visited with us on Monday and spent some time out with pupils at break time, met with staff and also with myself and our CEO Mrs Robinson to finalise our staffing plans for next year. More details of these plans will be shared with you in the coming weeks.

We also have the very exciting news to share that Mrs Tyson is going to begin her role as Lothersdale School's Headteacher earlier than expected, starting on Monday 3 July, rather than in September. This will give us 4 weeks of additional time this term all working together and a great start for her to get to know pupils, staff and families, as well as our school systems and curriculum, before the new school year begins.

The other leadership roles we currently have established in school (myself as Executive Head, with Mrs Bateman and Mr Craven as Heads of School) will continue alongside Mrs Tyson's role until the end of term – which will be a huge benefit to the school in terms of staffing and leadership. Mrs Tyson is writing a letter to introduce herself to everyone which will be sent out to parents/carers early next week. She will also be with school staff again at a YCAT HT and Admin Conference on 13 June and joining us for our first full school transition day on 28 June 2023.




New Playground Markings
