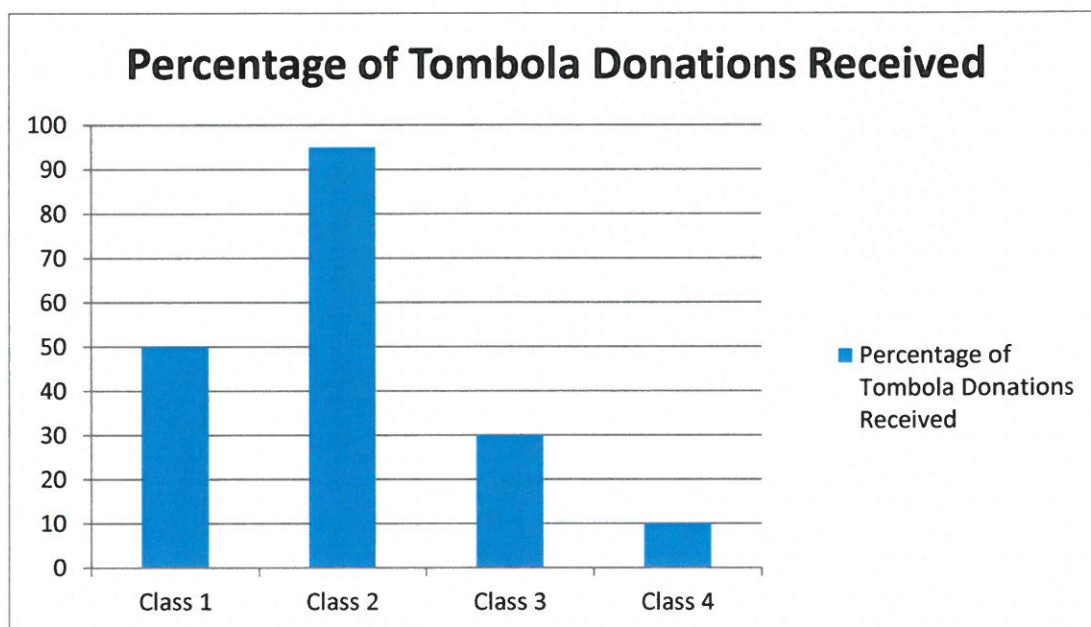

Class 4 Science Day

On Thursday Class 4 were thrilled to welcome into school Mr Willoughby, a science teacher from South Craven School. They spent the morning learning about the function of the heart in a practical way. Using squares of paper to represent oxygenated and deoxygenated blood, they modelled the journey that blood takes around the body.

Following this they investigated an animal heart and lungs, having the opportunity to handle and watch them being dissected. They even inserted a plastic tube into the lungs and inflated it with a bicycle pump! 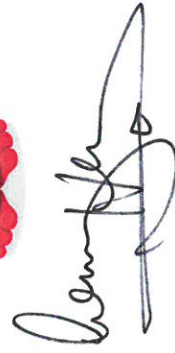
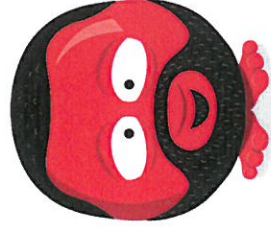
