#### Hello everyone!

This week it was great to see so many lessons and activities making the most of our wonderful outdoor environments around school and the village park to enhance learning in the fabulous summer weather we have been blessed with – let's hope it continues for a while longer!

Together with subject leader Mrs Knight, I have enjoyed monitoring Geography this week, including visiting some exciting lessons in Classes 1, 2 and 4, and talking to some pupils with their books. We were impressed by all pupils' ability to demonstrate and talk confidently about the new knowledge they are learning in their current units of work. This included lots of detail about volcanoes and tectonic plates in Class 4, following compass directions linked to local study of maps and our village in Class 2, and creating their own maps of the school grounds in Class 1.

There are clearly many very enthusiastic budding Geographers in Lothersdale! It was also good to see how confident Class 4 pupils are in discussing the teaching approaches we use to help them learn and develop good behaviours for learning; these include knowledge checks before, during and after a unit of work to help build and recall learning and knowledge organisers in their books to support and remind them of key information.

Next week, I am looking forward to visiting Maths lessons across school with Mr Craven and talking to groups of pupils about their learning in this subject.

#### Wild Explorer Event ~ 3, 4 and 5 July 2023




