Traffic Management

School Council & Eco Team Update

This half-term we have been trying to reduce the amount of single-use plastic we use during lunchtime. This week we completed some lunchtime surveys to see how much plastic was in them.

What we saw: we found out that lots of people were wrapping their sandwiches in cling film.

Facts: unfortunately cling film is not recyclable or re-usable and, when we throw it away, it goes into landfill or ends up in oceans.

Top Tip: try and use tin foil instead of cling film to wrap your sandwiches in for your child's packed lunch because it is recyclable or it can be washed and reused.

North Yorkshire Schools' Debating Competition ~ Runners Up!



Lothersdale Primary School is incredibly proud of its Year 5 and 6 debating team who were runners-up on Friday 15 June 2018 in the County Finals of North Yorkshire Schools Debating Competition at the NYCC Council Chambers at County Hall, Northallerton.

It was the first time that Lothersdale School had ever entered a debating competition, when it competed and won the Craven Schools final in March 2018. This success earned the team of six children a place at the county finals last week, where the topic 'Is Social media a danger to children?' was debated by a total of eight teams from across the North Yorkshire region.

The teams were awarded points for their delivery and the factual content of the presentations made by the schools two main speakers for and against the theme and also the ability of the whole team to ask pertinent questions of other teams.

After a full morning of debating in the council chambers the judging panel of Cllr Robert Windass (Chairman of the Council), Cllr Cliff Trotter, Cllr Janet Sanderson (executive member for Children and Young People's Service) and Heather Russell (NYCC Educational Development Adviser for English) voted Riverside Primary School, Ripon the winners with Lothersdale School close runners up!
