Hello everyone!

This week it has been great to visit lessons across school and talk to pupils about their learning in **Geography** (Class 3) and **Maths** (Classes 1, 2 and 4). As usual, I was very impressed by how quickly pupils are grasping new learning and are confident to talk about their work. In Class 3, pupils were enjoying 'interviewing' each other to practise their geographical knowledge of Lothersdale in preparation for creating tourist leaflets about the village. In their Maths, Class 1 pupils were building good early understanding of doubles, halves and sharing; in Y2, pupils were confident in their use of tally charts to handle data and solve problems; and Y6 pupils demonstrated ability to use division methods.

All pupils I spoke to were very enthusiastic about their Maths and able to recall lots of prior learning from work across the year.

Congratulations to Mr Craven for getting through the **Y2 moderation** process with flying colours on Friday last week! Our school was chosen this year as part of the 10% of schools annually to have their Y2 end of year assessments moderated by North Yorkshire Local Authority. It was brilliant to hear that all of our teacher judgements were agreed and the quality of pupils' work praised by the assessors.

Miss Baker and Mrs Aldren have only been with us for a relatively short time, but have soon become part of the Lothersdale family and we wish them both well in their continued teaching careers as they move on to other schools. Mrs Hill has been a huge part of the school as a TA/HLTA for 7 years and as such, has had a great impact on so many pupils both past and present and on their teaching, learning and care, especially in Y5/6; we wish her good luck as she leaves her work in school to take up an exciting new career.

We will all get the chance to say goodbye and a special thank you to our staff and pupil leavers at the leavers events which will be coming up all too soon as we head into July next week!


