

COVID-19 UPDATE

North Yorkshire County Council have asked schools to share this update: Please be aware that cases of COVID-19 are increasing nationally, and this is reflected in the local school community. Government Guidance around the management of COVID-19 has not changed and the school continues with its control measures to help manage the spread of any infection.

The official advice remains that people with symptoms of a respiratory infection, such as COVID-19, and who have a high temperature or do not feel well, should try to stay at home and avoid contact with others. Those who are asked - or choose - to test and get a positive COVID-19 result, should try to stay at home and avoid contact with other people for 5 days following the day of their positive result. Free COVID19 testing is no longer available for the majority of the population, but tests can be purchased from local pharmacies (including many supermarket pharmacies).

If your child is unwell, we would be grateful if you could keep them at home in order to prevent the spread of any infection (including COVID-19) within school.


Commonwealth Games Legacy Event ~ Thursday 7 July 2022


LSA Summer Raffle
