

Our study of David Hockney and his artwork has continued this week. We have studied one of his early paintings called 'Woman with a sewing machine', which we learnt is a portrait of his mum. Hockney experimented with etchings in his work before being influenced by the Pop Art movement, producing many

famous pictures, one of which - 'A bigger splash', sold for a staggering \$90 million! Following our analysis of the diversity of his work and the thought process that accompanied his paintings, we will now produce pieces using Hockney's style as inspiration.

Lothersdale Primary School END OF THE SCHOOL YEAR ~ PAYMENTS

It is extremely important that all ParentPay accounts are up-to-date, and a zero or credit balance remains on accounts when school closes on Friday 19 July 2019. This is the end of our school financial year and a busy time in the school office, when all financial records are finalised to enable the YCAT finance team to close down the accounts for the year.

ParentPay has informed us that we currently have 14 accounts showing a debt amount and we would be grateful if parents/carers could keep a close check on their accounts over the remaining weeks to ensure a credit balance remains.

Year 6 Leavers

This is particularly important if your child is in Year 6 and about to leave us at the end of July and the following should be noted:

- If a credit balance remains on your child's account and you have other children remaining in the school, the credit amount can be transferred to the sibling account. Please inform the school office as soon as possible if you would like any remaining credit transferred after 19 July. If we have not heard from you by the end of term, then a refund will be made via ParentPay.
- If a credit balance remains on your child's account and you have no other children in school, a refund will be made via ParentPay.
- Your ParentPay account <u>must</u> show a zero or credit balance on 19 July, when your child leaves the school. We would therefore be grateful if you could keep all payments up-to-date prior to the end of term to avoid any outstanding debt.

Voluntary Contributions

If your account is still showing payment items requesting voluntary contributions, please ensure payment is made via ParentPay before 19 July 2019, because we would be very grateful to receive a contribution towards your child's educational visits or swimming lessons.
