



Traffic Management

Parking outside school has become an issue again and we have received complaints about parents/carers blocking access to private property and turning around at the Out of School Club.

Please may we ask all parents/carers to respect the people who live close to the school and that you **do not** park in front of drives, access ways etc ~ this includes access to fields and the main school vehicle entrance (staff are finding it difficult to turn into the school entrance due to blocked or partially blocked access).

Not only is this an important health and safety issue but villagers, who do not have children in the school, still need to be able to travel freely through the village and access their properties at these peak times. Please note that you are putting pedestrian's lives at risk by turning around near the Out of School Club and/or the school vehicle entrance. We would be grateful for your cooperation in this matter.

Snapchat Map



The North Yorkshire Safeguarding Board have sent an alert to all schools highlighting that the social media app Snapchat has introduced a new feature known as Snap Map, which it views as a potential risk for young people. Sharing locations can be a risky thing to do, as people you do not know may be able to make contact or see what you have posted. Snap Maps allows users to see where in the country their Snapchat contacts are, as well as seeing location based photos and videos. The Snap Map shows a user's Bitmoji, their cartoon avatar within Snapchat, pinpointed

on a world map. Users can then zoom into the map to see the exact location of their friends.

North Yorkshire Safeguarding Boards top tips for children for location sharing are:

1. Only share your location with people you know in person. Never share your location with strangers.
2. Don't add contacts to Snapchat if you don't know them in person.
3. Regularly review your settings and take an active decision about whether you want people to know your location. Remember you can switch this off at any time. Think about where you're sharing your location. Location services such as Snap Maps can lead people to your house. Think about what times you're on the app and whether these are locations you want to share - if not, then turn this off within your settings.

Woolcraft ~ 3D Collage of Lothersdale

This year the children in Woolcraft Club have worked extremely hard making a fantastic 3D 'knitted' model of the village of Lothersdale.

Initially the children were asked to write down what Lothersdale, and especially the school, meant to them so that their ideas could be incorporated into the model.



One child said that "Lothersdale Primary School is really small so you know everyone and it is friendly". Another wrote that they "liked the fun things that we do in Class 4".

The group also thought about the buildings and surrounding area of the school, to represent the history of Lothersdale. This includes the park (where the children play sports), the garden (where they learn about growing flowers and vegetables), and the stream running through the village (with the bridge, the mill tower and smoke).

The group then used yarn to knit with and some of the children used their own initiative and creative skills to make flowers for the garden. In addition they thought about texture, as well as the visual effect of the materials used for each part of the model.

Finally, all the members of WoolCraft were adamant that there should be a rainbow over the school; even though it rains a lot in Lothersdale the sun always comes out and shines over our school.

Miss Gallagher and Mrs Outhwaite are very impressed with all the children who have contributed to the 3D collage of Lothersdale. Many thanks to Mrs Outhwaite for committing so much time to this very successful club.

ParentPay Credit Facility

Please note that you can hold credit on your ParentPay account to assist with family budgeting. To set this up on your ParentPay account, click on 'add Parent Account Credit' and follow any instructions. You can add credit into this account at any time and then draw on it to pay for future school trips, meals, Extended Schools' activities etc.

Please inform the school office by Thursday 13 July 2017 if your child will be changing his/her lunchtime arrangements in September. This will enable Mrs Varley to predict numbers for food orders for the beginning of the academic year.

Residential Visit to Humphrey Head in the autumn term (current Year 4 & 5 pupils)

Please remember that ParentPay is currently set up to accept payments for this autumn term's residential visit to Humphrey Head, near Cartmel, which will involve current Year 4 and Year 5 pupils. This allows payments to be made in regular instalments and parents/carers can determine how much to pay at any given time as long as full payment is made by the stated deadline.
