Dolce Schools Catering ~ Direct Debit Payments

A letter was emailed this week to parents/carers of children in Class 3 and Class 4 regarding direct debit payments. If you currently pay for your child's meals by direct debit then please ensure you are aware of the date all direct debit payments will cease.

End of Financial Year ~ Outstanding Payments

It is extremely important that all ParentPay and SchoolGrid accounts are up-to-date, and <u>a zero or credit</u> <u>balance remains on accounts</u> when school closes on Friday 21 July 2023. This is the end of our school financial year and a busy time in the school office when all financial records are finalised to enable the YCAT finance team to close down the accounts for the year.

Year 6 Leavers

This is particularly important if your child is in Year 6 and about to leave us at the end of July and the following should be noted:

- If a credit balance remains on your child's account and you have other children remaining in the school, the credit amount will be transferred to the sibling account.
- If a credit balance remains on your child's account and you have no other children in school, a refund will be made via ParentPay.
- Your ParentPay account <u>must</u> show a zero or credit balance on 21 July, when your child leaves the school. We would therefore be grateful if you could ensure your child's account is clear next week.
