Headteacher Update
From Mr Grogan

Please find detailed below Headteacher updates for your information. If you have any queries regarding any of the content below, please contact the school office.

Dear Parents/Carers

This week the Prime Minister announced that national restrictions will be lifted from 19th July, our last week of term. At the same time, we were told that the requirement to self-isolate for contacts of positive covid cases will be removed on 16th August; from this point, children and double-jabbed adults do not need to isolate if they come into contact with a positive case.

During the 4-week period between these two dates, the legal requirement to self-isolate is still in place, which means if your child comes into contact with a positive case of Covid before August 16th they would have to self-isolate.

For this reason, we will not be making any changes to our risk assessment in school for the final week; children will remain in their bubbles, lunches will continue to be served separately, playtimes will still be split and visitors will still not be allowed in school.

If we were to lift restrictions in school and allow all children to mix together, then we would effectively become one bubble. If a positive case was then detected in school (child or adult), it could result in the whole school being told to self-isolate.

I know that many parents/carers (myself included) are anxious about upcoming, long-awaited family holidays, and the last thing you need is to be told during the last week of term that school is closing and that your children have to self-isolate.

I am sure that you will understand this decision and appreciate the reasons outlined above. It will mean that...

- The Year 6 leavers' production will go ahead outdoors, with full PA system so you can hear your children speak.
- The end of term discos will go ahead outdoors with children separated into class bubbles (or indoors in separate classes if the weather isn't great, but please note this will be a last minute decision).

Yesterday, we had the most wonderful day as Sports Day was a resounding success. Thank you to all family members who were able to attend, and I hope you enjoyed the day as much as the children did. I was particularly pleased to see so many families there, as that is the kind of event that you have really missed out on during the pandemic. I am confident that next year we will have lots of reasons to invite you in to school, and we will be able to get back to being the wonderful community that I know Lothersdale is.

Thank you to all our staff for their efforts in making Sports Day a success; I'm sure you can appreciate there is a lot of work goes into an event like that, especially working with Covid restrictions. Thanks especially to Miss Laycock's partner, Wayne, for coming up first thing to erect the 'sheep pens' for parents to stand in.

Next Tuesday we will be holding a transition morning in school to give all the children who are changing classes the opportunity to spend time in their new classroom and with their new teachers. The teachers are very much looking forward to this, particularly as they have not been able to forge the same relationships with children from other classes as in previous years; there's a bit of catching up to do in that respect, but we will more than make up for it in the new school year.

We will not be able to mix existing bubbles during transition, so if your child is staying in the same classroom next year, they will spend the morning with their current teaching assistant in the hall or the music room where they will be able to think about what the new school year will be like for them.

I'm sure it has escaped no one's notice that there is a very special sporting event taking place this weekend; I know lots of the children have been following the Euros very closely, and their excitement has been growing as England have progressed through each stage.

No doubt many children will be staying up extra-late on Sunday evening to watch the match, and as a result they will not get anything like the amount of sleep they need. In recognition of this fact, and the fact that this is a truly once-in-a-lifetime experience, if you are able to, and if you're child really needs the extra rest, you can bring them to school later than usual on Monday morning. **We will keep the registers open and will not mark children late, provided they are in school by 10.30am.**

I know lots of children will have to come into school at the usual time as parents have to go to work, just like our staff do; school will be open as normal and all staff will be here ready to welcome the vast majority of children at the usual time.

I hope you all have a wonderful weekend, and let's hope that football does indeed come home on Sunday.

Come on England!

Reading & Library books must be returned in the last week of school and we would be grateful if you could ensure all books are back in school by Friday 23 July 2021.


Sports Day ~ Thursday 8 July 2021



End of Financial Year ~ Outstanding Payments

It is extremely important that all ParentPay accounts are up-to-date, and a zero or credit balance remains on accounts when school closes on Friday 23 July 2021. This is the end of our school financial year and a busy time in the school office, when all financial records are finalised to enable the YCAT finance team to close down the accounts for the year.

ParentPay has informed us that we currently have 9 accounts showing a debt amount and we would be grateful if parents/carers could keep a close check on their accounts over the next two weeks to ensure a credit balance remains and any outstanding contributions are made if possible.

Year 6 Leavers

This is particularly important if your child is in Year 6 and about to leave us at the end of July and the following should be noted:

- If a credit balance remains on your child's account and you have other children remaining in the school, the credit amount can be transferred to the sibling account. Please inform the school office as soon as possible if you would like any remaining credit transferred after 23 July. If we have not heard from you by the end of term, then a refund will be made via ParentPay.
- If a credit balance remains on your child's account and you have no other children in school, a refund will be made via ParentPay.
- Your ParentPay account must show a zero or credit balance on 23 July, when your child leaves the school. We would therefore be grateful if you could keep all payments up-to-date prior to the end of term to avoid any outstanding debt.

School Lunch Arrangements ~ September 2021

Year 2: thank you for letting us know your child's lunchtime arrangements from September 2021. A text was sent out today to those parents/carers who have not yet informed us and we would be grateful if you could email the school office by Monday 12 July.

Years 3, 4, & 5: thank you for letting us know if your child will be changing their lunchtime arrangement from September. This has now been amended on our school system.

Please note that two week's **term time** notice is required if your child wishes to change from school lunch to pack-up and vice-versa and therefore any changes to lunchtime arrangements from Monday 12 July, will be taken into account w/c 20 September 2021. This is because the food order for the beginning of the academic year will be made by Mrs G next week.

Residential Visit to Humphrey Head in the autumn term (current Year 4 & 5 pupils)

Please remember that ParentPay is currently set up to accept payments for this autumn term's residential visit to Humphrey Head, near Grange-over-Sands which will involve current Year 4 and Year 5 pupils. This allows payments to be made in regular instalments and parents/carers can determine how much to pay at any given time as long as full payment is made by the stated deadline.

Residential Visit to Eshton Grange in May 2022 (current Year 3 pupils)

Please note that the Year 4 (current Year 3 pupils) visit to Eshton Grange will take place from Wednesday 25 May 2022 to Friday 27 May 2022, which is in the last week before the May half-term holiday. ParentPay will be set up to accept payment for this visit in the autumn term. This will allow parents/carer to make regular instalments and you can determine how much to pay at any given time as long as full payment is made by the stated deadline.




