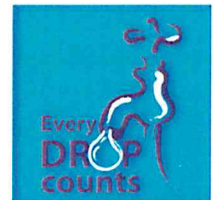

School Council & Eco Team Update

This week we are thinking about the environment and the impact the recent long spell of hot weather has had on water supplies, which has seen many households running low on water or not having any water at all. Please see our **Top Tips** below to help conserve water:

- Take shorter showers
- Only use your washing machine when it is full
- Turn off the tap while brushing teeth
- If you spot any leaks, act sooner rather than later to get them fixed
- Use an eco-dishwasher program
- Do not water your lawn ~ if it turns brown it will recover when it rains again
- Think before you water your flowers ~ re-use water you have already used
- Avoid using hosepipes to wash your car
- Only fill the kettle to the level you need



At Lothersdale Primary School we are now using bottled water for the last two weeks of term to help conserve the water supply in the village.

Class 1, Class 2 & Year 5 ~ 2018/2019 Influenza Programme

Class 2 ~ Swimming Lessons

Class 2 & Class 3 Presentation ~ The Life of Jesus
