Hello everyone!

This week, Mrs Tyson and I have had the exciting task of interviewing for our new 0.2 (1 day weekly) Class 3 teacher who will be job-sharing with Mrs Knight. We are pleased to announce that we have appointed Mrs Jenny Atkins, a local, very experienced Y3/4 teacher with specialisms in Computing and Science. She will be teaching Class 3 on Fridays from September, with Mrs Knight teaching Monday to Thursdays. As part of the interview process, we involved our current Y2 and Y3 pupils who will be making up the new Class 3 next year, as well as the rest of the Class 3 staff team. All pupils took part with enthusiasm in the interview lessons with our candidates and were great ambassadors for our school.


The children had a lovely time and Mrs Bateman and Mrs Gallagher were so proud of the children as we hit a big rain shower on the way back to school and ended up getting wet!

End of Financial Year ~ Outstanding Payments

It is extremely important that all ParentPay and SchoolGrid accounts are up-to-date, and <u>a zero or credit</u> <u>balance remains on accounts</u> when school closes on Friday 21 July 2023.

Year 6 Leavers

This is particularly important if your child is in Year 6 and about to leave us at the end of July and the following should be noted:

- If a credit balance remains on your child's account and you have other children remaining in the school, the credit amount will be transferred to the sibling account.
- If a credit balance remains on your child's account and you have no other children in school, a refund will be made via ParentPay.
- Your ParentPay account <u>must</u> show a zero or credit balance on 21 July, when your child leaves the school. We would therefore be grateful if you could ensure your child's account is clear next week.




Grow a £1 Project
