Extended Schools Activities ~ Autumn Term

Extended Schools Activities will resume week commencing Monday 11 September 2017. End of the School Year ~ Payments

It is extremely important that all ParentPay accounts are up-to-date, and a zero or credit balance remains on accounts, on 21 July 2017. This is particularly important if your child is in Year 6 and leaving school. Mrs Ellison will be carrying out an end of year return on ParentPay next week and we would be grateful if parents/carers could support her by settling their school meal accounts by today, Friday 21 July 2017, at the latest.

School Meal Payments for Children in Years 3, 4, 5 and 6

PLEASE NOTE SCHOOL MEAL INCREASE FROM SEPTEMBER

The cost of a school meal from September 2017 will increase to £2.30 per meal for children in Class 3 and Class 4. Please note the following:

- School meals must be paid for in advance. ParentPay automatically generates a list of outstanding dinner money each week and reminder letters will be issued to parents/carers accordingly. Please help us keep administrative time and costs to a minimum by ensuring your child's meal account is kept up-to-date.
- For parents/carers who wish to pay weekly the cost will be £11.50 per child.
- For parents/carers who wish to pay up to half-term (Friday 20 October 2017) the cost will be £78.20.*
- For parents/carers who wish to pay for the full term (up to and including Friday 22 December 2017) the cost will be £170.20.*

**please remember to deduct/adjust for pupil illness, educational visits etc., when making payments over the year.*

Friday Meals (for those pupils who have packed lunches)

If you have informed school that your child would like to have a school meal on Fridays during the autumn term, the cost will be £34.50 via ParentPay. If you wish to pay this amount in full, please pay via the Pupil Meals Service of your ParentPay account. Alternatively, you can pay weekly but note that payment must be made in advance.

ParentPay payments for the new academic year

Please note that ParentPay end of year will take place over the next two weeks and the switch over to the new academic year will be at the beginning of September. Extended Schools Activities will be input onto ParentPay over the holidays.

ParentPay Credit Facility

Please note that you can hold credit on your ParentPay account to assist with family budgeting. To set this up on your ParentPay account, click on 'add Parent Account Credit' and follow any instructions. You can add credit into this account at any time and then draw on it to pay for future school trips, meals, Extended Schools' activities etc.

Residential Visit to Humphrey Head in the autumn term (current Year 4 & 5 pupils)

Full details of this visit will be sent out to parents/carers at the beginning of the Autumn Term. Please remember that the Humphrey Head Payment Account is already set up on ParentPay to enable parents/carers to pay regular amounts at your convenience. The deadline for full payment for this visit is 29 September 2017.

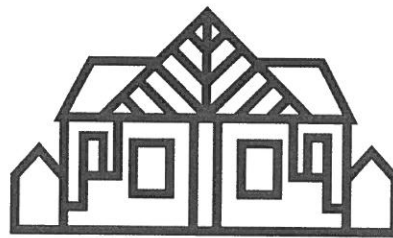

**EXTENDED SCHOOLS ACTIVITIES ~ AUTUMN TERM 2017 ~ FIRST HALF
NOTES FOR PARENTS/CARERS**

- 1 Please complete a separate form for each child. All children are encouraged to take part in at least one 'sporty' club to support all children at Lothersdale Primary School developing healthy lifestyles.
- 2 **FREE ACTIVITIES (Autumn Term First Half):** To give as many children the chance to participate in one free club during the week, please rank clubs they would like to attend in order of preference. Forms must be returned to school by Wednesday 6 September 2017.
- 3 **PAID ACTIVITIES (Autumn Term):** Places for paid activities will be allocated when payment has been made via ParentPay. The deadline for payments for Autumn Term First Half is Wednesday 6 September 2017 and Autumn Term Second Half is Monday 16 October 2017. Please do not return the activities' form for these activities as activity lists will be generated following receipt of payment.
- 4 The extended schools activities will be removed from ParentPay once the deadline has passed so it is important that payments are made promptly. Unfortunately we will be unable to add your child to an activity list once the deadline for a paid activity has passed.
- 5 This form will be valid for the autumn term first half for Free Staff Led activities and for the whole of the autumn term for paid activities ~ clubs start on Monday 11 September 2017.
 - First Aid and Heart Start is an on-going 10 week course and the last session is scheduled to finish on Friday 1 December 2017 (there will be no club on Friday 20 October due to the Humphrey Head residential).
- 6 Please note that, when signing your child up for an activity, you are agreeing to pay for him/her to attend all the sessions.
- 7 Refunds will only be given if the session is cancelled by the provider due to illness or other extenuating circumstances.
- 8 Medical and Parental consent for activities to be carried out off site is covered by the annual Parental Consent for a Rolling Programme or Series of Local Visits completed at the beginning of the academic year.
- 9 Please note that you can withdraw consent in writing at any time and parents must inform the school of any changes to medical or other circumstances to enable us to keep our records up-to-date.
- 10 There may be circumstances when Extended Schools Activities do not go ahead and school will endeavour to inform parents as soon as possible regarding any changes. Please ensure your contact details held on file are current.
- 11 Wool Craft is free to children who have previously attended. If your child is new to the club please send them with a pair of 4mm needles to get them started.

- ✦ The Therapist will need to know why you are attending the Drop In and what specific concerns you have about your child's communication.
- ✦ You will have to wait to see the Therapist as these sessions will be busy.
- ✦ Interpreters are not available at the drop in.
