

## SAFER BEHAVIOURS AND ACTIONS

that will help reduce the  
spread of COVID-19

It remains important for everyone, including those who are fully vaccinated, to follow behaviours and actions that reduce transmission and help to keep people safe. Following the recommended actions will also help limit the spread of seasonal illnesses, including flu.

The risk of catching or passing on COVID-19 can be higher in certain places and when doing certain activities. In general, the risk of catching or passing on COVID-19 is higher in crowded spaces (where there are more people who might be infectious) and in enclosed indoor spaces (where there is limited fresh air). Some activities, such as singing, dancing, and exercising can also increase the risk of transmission of COVID-19 as people are doing activities which generate more particles as they breathe.

The following behaviours are encouraged to prevent COVID spreading:



Let fresh air in if you meet indoors. Meeting outdoors is safer



Wear a face covering in crowded and enclosed settings where you come into contact with people you do not normally meet



Get tested, and self isolate if required



Try to stay at home if you are feeling unwell



Wash your hands



Download and use the NHS COVID-19 app

Class 1 have now completed their fourth week of school (how time flies) and their third week of our phonics programme! Together we have learnt the letter sounds for s, a, t, i, p and n. During daily lessons, the children work with Mrs Bateman, Mrs Gallagher and Miss Grundy as a whole class. They then also work in additional smaller groups to ensure the best possible start to their learning at Lothersdale School.

Together we read letters and words and even spell by counting sounds on our fingers. Our class big book (shared via the smartboard) is sparking the children's imaginations. Nip and Nap, the alien characters we are following, have really caught the children's interest.

To support your child further and help their developing phonic ability please play this simple (but REALLY effective) game with them at home or in the car.

**"I hear with my little ear, the word that is made of /c/a/t/" (children say full word, cat).**

**"I hear with my little ear the word that is made of /f/i/sh/" (children say full word, fish).**

When they are confident with this play the harder version -

**"I hear with my little ear the sounds that make up hop" (children say /h/o/p).**

**"I hear with my little ear the sounds that make up chip" (children say /ch/i/p/)**

This simple spoken game can make all the difference and give your child a great confidence boost!

Everyone has really settled down this week in Class 2 and produced their best work yet. Routines and expectations are becoming more embedded, and it is clear to see the desire of everybody to achieve their very best.

We have begun to look at nouns in our English work and the children have developed their knowledge of nouns and they are able to identify nouns within a sentence. In maths we have continued with our number work. I have been so impressed with the resilience and attitudes to learning from our Year 2 children. We have been looking at partitioning in different ways and they have all really applied themselves fully to the learning. The children have been able to answer some tricky reasoning problems and use the vocabulary of tens and ones to explain their answers. The Year 1 children have developed their knowledge of 'more' and 'less than' and are beginning to work more accurately and with increasing independence. Well done Class 2, keep it up.

As you may be aware, we recently made a significant investment in a new phonics and reading programme, called **Rocket Phonics**. This programme will enable us to meet the twin goals of:

- ✦ giving all our children a solid base upon which to build as they progress through school
- ✦ helping all our children to develop the habit of reading widely and often, for both pleasure and information

Phonics can be extremely confusing for parents, and reading with your children can be quite daunting if you are not familiar with the 'phonics code'. Parents often report being bemused when, for example, their 5-year-old tells them off for not recognising a split-digraph.

For this reason, we would like to extend a warm welcome to all parents of children in Class 1 and 2 to a training event in Class 2. Mr. Craven will guide you through the basics of phonics, introduce you to terms such as blending and segmenting, and give you tips on how to best support your young child when reading at home.

We will be running the session at 3.15pm so you don't have to make special arrangements or make an extra trip to school. Your children can join Mrs Bateman's Magic Book Club for the time that you are in the meeting. Please keep babies and toddlers with you unless you can make alternative arrangements for them. 
