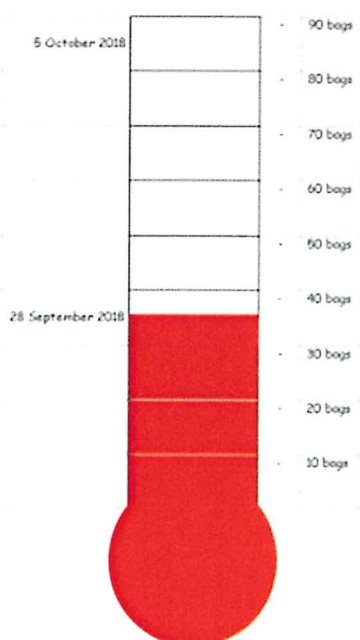


Class 3 and Class 4 ~ Tuesday 9 October 2018
