Class 3 Viking Day ~ Monday 15 October 2018

As part of our history project this term, Class 3 will be taking part in a Viking workshop on Monday 15 October 2018. A Viking will be coming to Lothersdale Primary School to teach us about life in Viking times between AD 793 and 1066.

We have made Viking helmets and shields and if children would like to come dressed up as Viking children they can do on this day. Viking clothes were made from linen, wool and animal skins. Men wore tunics and trousers and women wore long dresses with a pinafore over it. Clothes were fastened with belts and brooches. Children could therefore wear:



Boys ~ school trousers + shirt with a belt around the middle.

Girls ~ a long skirt/dress with an apron/grey pinafore dress with a belt/brooch


