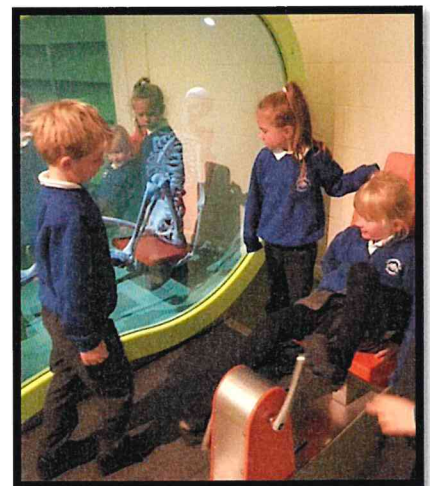


### Class 2 Visit to Eureka Children's Museum Thursday 5 October 2017

If you think your child may need to take non-prescribed or prescribed medicine during the residential visit and staff have not been made aware, then please complete the Administering Medicine Form, which is available to download from the Class 4 page on the school website. Completed forms and medicine must be brought into school no later than the morning of 16 October and handed to Mrs Fawcett or the school office. ***Please do not pack any medicine in your child's bags or hand to a member of staff on Monday morning without completing the appropriate form.***

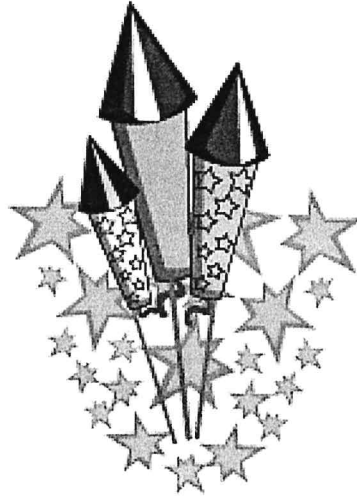
