#### Traffic Management

Parking outside school has become an issue again and we have received complaints this week about poor parking and cars turning around in private drives. One of the villagers was also unable to gain access to property due to a car blocking the gate.

Please may we ask all parents/carers to respect the people who live close to the school and that you do not park or turn around in front of drives, access ways etc ~ this includes access to fields and the main school vehicle entrance. Please also refrain from parking where the road narrows, which causes problems for farm traffic and emergency vehicles. Residents are becoming less tolerant and those affected by this inconsiderate behaviour are now taking down vehicle registration numbers.

Not only is this an important health and safety issue but villagers, who do not have children in the school, still need to be able to travel freely through the village and access their properties at these peak times. We would be grateful for your cooperation in this matter.




Thank you to everyone who has supported our Harvest 90kg Rice Challenge and helped us reach our target. The bag(s) of

#### Whole School Storytelling Workshops ~ Thursday 18 October



All classes will be taking part in a morning of 'storytelling' on Thursday 18 October 2018 when we welcome Gauri Raje into school, to help us celebrate Black History Month. Gauri is an anthropologist and storyteller who works in the UK and India with schools, adults and vulnerable groups. She performs

regularly in the UK, India and Europe. Her other performance projects include directing 'East of the Sun, West of the Moon' a collection of stories for adults from around the world translated and told in 3 different Indian languages, and 'Badlands', a storytelling of folk stories of the land and rivers of central India and 'Tales of Exile and Sanctuary', stories from around the world exploring themes of exile. She is currently working with biographical and traditional stories of South Asian migrants to the West of Scotland with AwazFM, a South Asian radio station in Glasgow.



- PAID ACTIVITIES: Places for paid activities will be allocated when payment has been made via ParentPay. The deadline for payments for Autumn Term Second Half is <u>Monday 22 October 2018</u>. Please do not return the activities' form for these activities as activity lists will be generated following receipt of payment.
- The extended schools activities will be removed from ParentPay once the deadline has passed so it is important that payments are made promptly. <u>Unfortunately we will be unable to add your child to an activity list once the deadline for a paid activity has passed.</u>
- 5 Please note that, when signing your child up for an activity, you are agreeing to pay for him/her to attend all the sessions.
