HEADTEACHER update

Dear Parents and Carers,

It was good to see so many parents in school and in church for our Harvest Festival celebrations this week. I really enjoyed the church event and thought the children sang very well. I do think we could do something about amplifying the children's voices next time, as I could hear them speak really well and confidently from the front pew, however, I am aware that those further back could not hear.

I need to ask for your help and support this afternoon on behalf of the LSA. Each year the LSA raises thousands of pounds for school, and this always makes a significant difference to our budget. Without those funds, we would never have been able to redevelop the library and purchasing the Rocket Phonics programme and books would have left a huge dent in our school budget.

This year, with fuel costs spiralling, we will be even more reliant upon income that comes from sources beyond central government funding, and the LSA provides us with the bulk of that. Currently, the work that goes into organising LSA events (movie nights, Christmas Fair etc.) is done by a very small number of people, and they would dearly love more people to be involved.

Please come along to the LSA AGM on Monday 17th at 7PM in school – we are starting preparations for the Christmas Fair now (Santa is booked already!), and we need your help!
