

Please note that only 41% of contributions have been received to date towards this term's Class 3 swimming lessons and the school needs at least 85% to make it financially viable. Please note that, although these lessons are part of the school curriculum, the school receives no extra funding for swimming and relies on parental contributions to enable the children to take part in this activity. The deadline for receipt of contributions is Monday 4 November 2019. No child will be excluded if his or her parents/carers do not contribute, but if insufficient voluntary contributions are received then regrettably, this activity will not continue.

#### Medicine

Please do not bring any prescribed or non-prescribed medicines into school on Monday unless you have completed an Administering Medicine form. Please note that medicines, including non-prescriptive medicines such as Calpol or travel sickness tablets, <u>cannot</u> be given to children unless a form has been completed.

If you think your child may need to take non-prescribed or prescribed medicine during the residential visit and staff have not been made aware, then please complete the Administering Medicine Form, which is available to download from the Class 4 page on the school website. Completed forms and medicine <u>must</u> be brought into school on 21 October 2019 and handed to Mrs Fawcett or the school office. Please <u>do not</u> pack any medicine in your child's bags. All medicines must NOT be handed to a member of staff on Monday morning without completing the appropriate form.
