Health & Safety Update

Traffic Management

Parking outside school has become an issue again and we have received complaints this week about poor parking. One of the villagers was unable to leave for work on Wednesday morning due to a parent parking across the access to his property.

Please may we ask all parents/carers to respect the people who live close to the school and that you **do not** park in front of drives, access ways etc ~ this includes access to fields and the main school vehicle entrance. Staff have also been unable to drive into school recently due to blocked access.

Not only is this an important health and safety issue but villagers, who do not have children in the school, still need to be able to travel freely through the village and access their properties at these peak times. We would be grateful for your cooperation in this matter.

Vomiting and diarrhoea

We currently have a diarrhoea and/or sickness bug going round school at the moment and we would like to reiterate the school's policy that children should be kept off school until at least 48 hours after their symptoms have gone. If your child has been sick, please **do not** send them in to school until the 48 hours have elapsed since their last bout of illness.

If you have been asked to come and collect your child from school because they are suffering from either diarrhoea and/or vomiting, please ensure they do not return to school until the 48 hours have elapsed since their last bout of illness.

This is the advice given to us by the Health Protection Agency and we would be grateful if parents/carers could adhere to this guidance to ensure the infection does not spread to other children or staff in school.

Headlice

There have been reported outbreaks of head lice in school, particularly in Class 3. Would parents please check over the weekend and take preventative measures over the half-term break where necessary. Long hair should be tied back for school.

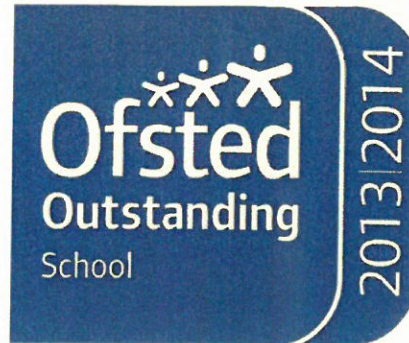
